

Documents required for initial “Talent Chercheur” residence permit application

Documents to be uploaded on the ANEF website

- Long-stay visa (“visa de long séjour” marked «L313-20 4°» or Talent Chercheur, C. SEJ. A SOLLIC.)
- Or “visa de long séjour valant titre de séjour (VLS-TS)” marked «L313-20 4°» or Talent Chercheur and the visa validation confirmation
- Valid passport (with photocopies of all pages that have been written on, or stamped)
- Documentation of civil status: marriage certificate (+ apostille/legalization if necessary), children’s birth certificates (with parents listed), declaration of non-polygamy (if you are from a country where polygamy is permitted).
- e-photo number (recent identity photos)
- Proof of residence from within the last six months:

If you are a tenant, you must include a bill (water, gas, electricity, landline telephone, etc.) or a proof you subscribed to a housing insurance. However, if you are staying in a hotel, residence or at the Faculty Club, you must ask for a certificate of domicile (attestation de domicile) and an invoice for the last month of rent. Finally, if you are hosted by a private individual, the host must complete and sign a hosting certificate (attestation d’hébergement), provide proof of address in their name from within the last 6 months, as well as a copy of their identification.

- «Convention d’accueil»
- French work contract or convention de séjour de recherche
- Your most recent degree: master diploma or PhD if applicable.
- For PhD students enrolled at Université Côte d’Azur: a proof of enrollment at the University

Please present the original and a copy of your documents, in addition to a French translation made by a sworn translator from the Appeal Court of Aix en Provence.

- Tax stamps (timbres fiscaux) to the value of the fee (€ 225). You can buy it online [here](#).

(to give to the Prefecture when you pick up your resident permit, so purchase it only when the Prefecture informs you that your card is ready.).
