

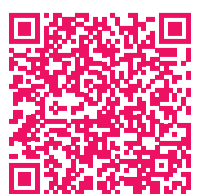

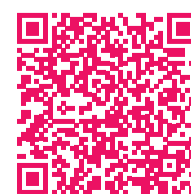

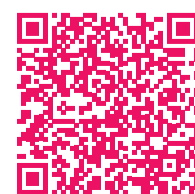


**Drama during the exam
