



Creation of the *Maison de l'Europe et des Territoires* (Europe and Territories Centre)

Université Côte d'Azur is pleased to announce the creation of the [Maison de l'Europe et des Territoires \(MET\)](#), a unique and transversal service for the submission and monitoring of regional, national, European and international projects. The MET continues the momentum initiated by UCA since 2018 - 428 European, national and regional projects submitted and a success rate of 32% - and its missions, among others, are:

- Better inform the research and training community about funding opportunities;
- Offer effective and tailor-made support to teacher-researchers and researchers in the process of project development and submission;
- Strengthen the visibility of the University and its integration into the European and territorial ecosystem through structural projects.

The MET works jointly with the partners of the IDEX within the framework of the Joint Europe Unit, which brings together UCA, CNRS, INRIA, OCA and CHU in order to best support European dynamics at site level.

Ulysseus: the European University project

UCA is involved in several internationalization projects, the flagship project for the start of the 2020 academic year being the creation of a [European University called Ulysseus](#). This Alliance project was selected by the European Commission, which is funding its deployment over 3 years.



The Ulysseus Alliance is based on six higher education establishments, firmly grounded in their territory: Universidad de Sevilla (Spain), Haaga-Helia Applied Science University (Finland), Management Center Innsbruck (Austria), Technical University of Kosice (Slovakia), Università degli studi di Genova (Italy), Université Côte d'Azur (France). Ulysseus's ambition is to create a community where universities, territorial and local authorities, businesses, entrepreneurs, students and citizens form an ecosystem of innovation to build the European cities of tomorrow.

The development of the Alliance takes place on the one hand through the constitution of the Ulysseus community (members of the consortium, associated partners and beneficiaries), and on the other hand with the creation of the Ulysseus campus. This campus integrates new common structures and in particular: a virtual platform, a joint international centre and several innovation centres.

The Project Assistance Request Form

The Joint Europe Unit has developed, with help from UCA's IT Department, an online [Request form for assistance](#) in setting up projects which is intended for all researchers or teacher-researchers from UCA, CNRS and OCA research units of the Côte d'Azur site, who wish to develop and submit a project. This form will be used in order to ask for and benefit from support in the process of setting up and submitting projects.

This form concerns all research units (the management structure of the research unit will be observed in both the form processing and the project submission process) and all type of grants (regional, national, European). This form will be the privileged way to contact us and seek assistance from our service in order to benefit from personalized support.

How it works? The project investigator fills in the form in 5 minutes, answering a few questions. The form is automatically submitted to the validation of the Research Unit Director and sent to the operational team. In a maximum of one week, the project investigator receives an answer to his request and the assistance process is put in place.



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3rd year students in Economics and Management: Take part in virtual mobility with MOVIDIS

The [MOVIDIS](#) project (ERASMUS+ Strategic Partnership) opened a call for applications for students in the 3rd year of a Bachelor of Economics and Management at Université Côte d'Azur, who wish to get involved in a virtual study or tutoring experience that will take place over 6 months in 2021.



The main objective of Movidis is the implementation of virtual student mobility between the partner universities: Université Côte d'Azur, Università degli studi di Torino, Università degli studi di Genova, Universidad Complutense de Madrid, University of Seville, Fachhochschule des Mittelstands.

IESP project: Study visit to Université Côte d'Azur

Université Côte d'Azur organized on June 3 a study visit within the framework of the **IESP project - Fostering Internationalization at Montenegrin HEIs through Efficient Strategic Planning** bringing together Montenegrin partner universities, Montenegrin ministries of education and science and the Higher Education Quality Assurance and Control Agency.



Several aspects were discussed during this study visit such as the internationalization strategy, international programs, projects and agreements developed by UCA and their impact. This meeting enabled an exchange of good practices, which will serve as a basis for the development of guidelines for strengthening the internationalization of Montenegrin higher education institutions.
