Welcome Parties play a vital role in student life, especially for newcomers. These events are much more than just a celebration: they provide a space for meeting, sharing, and integration.



Ready, Immerse and Go! Erasmus + project - Ongoing works



The "Ready, Immerse and Go!" Erasmus+ project, coordinated by Université Côte d'Azur, which is working on the creation of an online platform of virtual scenarios that recreate particularly difficult situations for students who decide to go abroad for international mobility, is in the process of building virtual scenarios.

The partners in this project are still working on the creation of the different levels that will make up the virtual platform for students. The development

of these scenarios is a highly complex exercise, trying to combine the technical possibilities offered by the Sphere platform and the pedagogical needs that the partner universities of the project wish to cover. The degree of interaction between the participants, the realistic elements such as the 3D images used and other elements of sound or gamification are some of the concepts that the technicians involved are currently discussing. This practical exercise also aims to prepare them to continue working on the development of virtual reality as a pedagogical tool once the project is completed.

Call for applications to participate in the Erasmus + CURATE project



The CURATE Incubator project, funded by the Erasmus + programme, is an initiative of the European University Ulysseus, of which Université Côte d'Azur is a member. It is an online training programme focusing on entrepreneurship and artificial intelligence, including coaching sessions and exercises supervised by companies. A total of 15 students from Université Côte d'Azur will benefit from this programme.

The training programme, which will run from February to autumn 2025, will include elements such as business models and market analysis, entrepreneurial skills to stand out from the crowd, motivational challenges and group dynamics with intercultural teams.

The selected students, who must be enrolled in a Bachelor's or Master's degree programme at Université Côte d'Azur, must have a good command of English and a solid academic record, will also have the opportunity to attend the two-day face-to-face bootcamps in Münster (Germany) and Kosice (Slovakia) free of charge (travel and accommodation included). The MIN4CI Foundation, composed of Université Côte d'Azur, Aix-Marseille Université, Avignon Université and the Région Sud, is a founding member of the EIT Culture & Creativity, and as such intends to seize this opportunity to contribute to the European outreach of the ecosystem of the Région Sud

Erasmus+ Digit Africa project consortium meeting in Nice

An administrative meeting of the Digit Africa project took place on January 16th and 17th, 2025, bringing together the entire project consortium at Université Côte d'Azur to take stock of the project's administrative and financial situation, with one year

to go.

Among the most important points discussed were the next digital summit activities to be developed by each of the project's Guinean, Kenyan, Madagascan and Tunisian universities to establish a local digital culture accessible to all. The training courses developed for African academic staff by the European universities involved in the project (Université Côte d'Azur and Universidad de las Islas Baleares) and the visits to European digital centers organized since the start of the project have enabled African HEIs to acquire the skills they need to become the driving force behind digitization in their countries.


