

ERASMUS + TEST Project : Technologies for Steaming



Université Côte d'Azur is an active partner of the ERASMUS + T.E.S.T project.

The project "T.E.S.T.: Technologies for STEAM Teaching" responds to the Higher Education priority "Rewarding excellence in learning, teaching and skills development", by promoting, in line with the Digital excellence in learning, teaching and skills

development", promoting, in line with the Digital Education Plan 2021-2027, innovative and quality teaching and learning through new technologies. Education Plan 2021-2027, innovative and high-quality teaching and learning through new technologies and digital content for universities and teachers, especially in STEM+A disciplines, whose empirical nature is not compatible with distance learning.

Scientific, technological and artistic education, in fact, is based on students' experimentation in a laboratory, where theoretical models are confirmed, a practical, pragmatic, empirical orientation is provided, creativity and teamwork are stimulated.

These aspects require European universities to evolve, in a digital key, the forms, methods and opportunities for teaching/learning and that These aspects require European universities to evolve, in a digital key, the forms, methods and opportunities for teaching/learning and call on the teaching staff to evolve towards the role of the Adaptive Teacher, able to supervise the teaching and learning process. able to control digital teaching tools and introduce teaching methods that combine virtual and laboratory learning (learning to learn). Learning by e-doing, as a testing ground for introducing elements of flexibility, simplicity, accessibility, interactivity and personalisation, which are key indicators of quality in open learning.

Therefore, the project focuses on the co-development of a Learning Programme, as a didactic framework for training trainers for the development of digital, methodological, design and communicative-relational competences, necessary to design, deliver and evaluate STEM+A students' learning processes conceived, conducted and implemented in virtual laboratories based on doing, communicating and relating. virtual laboratories based on doing, acting and operating.

The partnership will use the DIGCOMPEdu model and the UNESCO reference framework as a standard for teachers' e-skills. UNESCO reference framework. For more info: https://project-test.unisi.it/

HYBOT - Enhancing hybrid teaching in higher education through chatbots



The HYBOT project, with the participation of Université Côte d'Azur, aims to explore the potentials of hybrid teaching for universities and to develop novel concepts. This is to be done with the help of chatbots, i.e. intelligent virtual assistants. Chatbots are already actively used in various industries for entertainment or information purposes. Chatbots can also play a significant role in education and specifically in the development and implementation of

hybrid learning scenarios by acting as digital assistants to teachers and taking over or supporting various functions.

To create and realise a good chatbot-based hybrid teaching concept requires specialised knowledge, pedagogical skills and, last but not least, a portion of enthusiasm. All these building blocks will be put together in the three-year HYBOT project with the aim of developing competences of university teachers in the conception and implementation of hybrid learning and teaching scenarios using chatbots.

For this purpose, supporting tools such as an online training programme for the development of chatbots, a handbook with the good practices of hybrid teaching in Europe and worldwide as well as a transnational "Community of Practice" will be developed and tested in the course of the project. In addition, university teachers participating in the project will demonstrate the acquired knowledge and competences by creating their own hybrid scenarios and chatbots and testing them with students.

In the long term, the project aims to contribute to the modernisation of learning settings at universities and to increase the reach of learning opportunities in post-pandemic times.

MINERVA: Université Côte d'Azur and its partners celebrate the completion of an ambitious project on Open Science



Launched in 2019, and successfully implemented despite the challenges of Covid, the MINERVA project, funded under Erasmus+ programme, has achieved its goal of building research capacity and open science capacities at universities in Armenia and Moldova. These achievements include the implementation of a national legal framework on open science in these two countries; and the implementation of the

European Strategy for Human Resources Excellence for Researchers (HSR4S).

In sum, the project consortium has contributed to the creation of real tools and skills to enable the long-term development and growth of open science in its many aspects. The final conference of the project took place on 1st and 2nd December 2022 in Chisinau, the Moldovan capital, attended by Université Côte d'Azur and the other member universities, as well as representatives of the ministries of the target countries.

QUADIC project moving ahead at full speed

The QUADIC project aims to promote and improve the international strategy of Kosovar and Albanian higher education institutions. To this end, several training sessions were carried out in various partner universities in Pristina and Tirana by experts in international relations from Université Côte d'Azur. We may cite the recent the training on "Dissemination and Communication Strategy and Challenges in EU projects. The goal of these trainings is to transfer knowledge and good practices on international strategy development and international project management. UCA.

This project has been extended for 6 months to make up for the delay caused by the health crisis, and will be completed in August 2023.
