OBERRED: Open science and the academic profession

Open science is seen as a new scientific paradigm for making research accessible, accountable, and effective. Open science is already changing the academic profession, from micro-practices to professional relationships with epistemic communities and stakeholders, with implications we are not yet able to foresee.

The OBERRED project "Open Badge Ecosystem for Recognition of Research Data Management and Sharing Skills" led by UCA, has provided significant insights in an article on open science in JEDEM (eJournal of eDemocracy and Open Government). The article delves first into literature and official documentation to unfold the discursive regimes which sustain the spread of open science. A specific focus is then devoted to the professional transition, highlighting the role of funding organizations in setting the new science environment and the subjective experience of academics. The article is completed by a case study in the field of Research Data Management where the misalignment among incumbent/changing processes can be more apparent.

The OBERRED participation aims to deliver training to academics on MDM through open education using an open system of skills recognition (badges). Finally, a research program focusing on how academic micropractices affect scientific organizations and structures is proposed.

Erasmus + LOGOPAS project : Consortium meeting in Nice on March 24 and 25



The Chateau de Valrose was the setting for the meeting of the ERAMUS + LOGOPAS project, with the participation of Université Côte d'Azur, on 24 and 25 March. The project partners, from Romania, Germany, Finland and Japan, came to Nice to present the results of the data collection and discuss the next steps to be taken.

The LOGOPAS project, whose main objective is to assess, promote and support local government involvement in physical activity and sport, aims to explore the current legally binding roles and responsibilities of local governments in promoting physical activity and sport and to support an increase in these roles and follow-up actions, sharing examples of good practice and proposing a set of criteria for the evaluation of these actions.

The participants of the meeting enjoyed a pleasant walk or bike ride along the Promenade des Anglais in Nice.

The QUADIC project is moving fast and forward!

The QUADIC consortium has picked up the pace to catch up after two years of remote work. Following the study visit carried out last February at the University of Perugia in Italy, a new study visit took place in Sofia, Bulgaria the last week of March.

The QUADIC project aims to promote and improve the international strategy of Kosovar and Albanian higher education institutions. In this context, the objective of this visit was to define the bases for the creation of a regional network of cooperation in the Balkans in the field of internationalization. Several workshops, presentations and discussions were held during these three working days to define the statues of this network, as well as the software that will be developed to facilitate the transfer of knowledge and good practices within this network.

During this visit, Université Côte d'Azur also led the work of analyzing and evaluating the performance of the international relations departments of our Kosovar and Albanian partners.
