Launch of the Horizon Europe program in France, followed by a series of webinars


The Horizon Europe program, its challenges and its objectives, were officially presented during a live kick-off on May 20, 2021, with the participation of Frédérique Vidal, Minister, and Mariya Gabriel, European Commissioner. The kick-off, focused on the political and strategic dimension of the program, is followed by a cycle of webinars in the form of thematic workshops on the different pillars and crosscutting topics, from May 21 to June 4. Registration for these webinars is mandatory.

Second Training for OPTIMA project partners (Erasmus +)

The Erasmus+ OPTIMA project (Open Practices, Transparency and Integrity for Modern Academia) continues its momentum!





Coordinated this time by the University of Science and Technology of Wroclaw (Poland), it was an opportunity for all participants to learn about themes as rich as they are diverse: UX / UI Design (Conception - User experience / User interface); Web Accessibility and to learn about the European General Data Protection Regulation. Participants were also able to put this training into practice through a hands-on exercise on the Miro application.

OPTIMA is a 3-year Capacity building project in the field of higher education (2021-2024), coordinated by the National Polytechnic University LVIV (Ukraine). Apart from Ukraine, it involves European partners from Austria, Belgium, France, the Netherlands and Poland.

New event for the MINERVA project (Erasmus +)

Université Côte d'Azur, member of the MINERVA Capacity Building project consortium, which aims to strengthen the Open Science practices of higher

education institutions in Moldova and Armenia, organized on April 22 an online study visit in order to present to our partners the UCA strategy in terms of human resources among researchers and the European label HRS4R.

Our partners were also able to benefit from several conferences and workshops on Open Science themes and UCA's practices in the fight against plagiarism. The expertise of UCA researchers and professionals enabled all participants to acquire new knowledge. MINERVA is a 3-year structural project coordinated by the Center for European Integration Studies of the Academy of Economic Studies of Moldova.

I AM EUROPE : a new public awareness project of Université Côte d'Azur

The "I AM Europe" project submitted last December was selected by the Representation of the European Commission in France in response to the call for "Actions and events in France on the European Union". The call aims to support information and communication actions on Europe in France, with the aim of bringing the European Union closer to its citizens and making the public better aware of the role and activities of the Union's institutions. European Union, to raise awareness, collect opinions and feedback and analyze these contributions to feed the decision-making process upstream.

The project is three-fold:

- Ulysseus component: Raising the awareness of pupils in second year classes in the Alpes-Maritimes about the action of the European Union in France with a competition game "Imagine your future as a European student". This action should allow high school students to project themselves into their future student life on a European scale;
- Alpes-Maritimes as experimentation territory: Raise public awareness of the impacts of R&D and cooperation policies and projects on the territory and on the daily lives of citizens with a "Did you know that Europe ..." campaign that will promote the projects that have been deployed in our territory;
- Innovation component: Raise awareness among students and the general public in the Alpes Maritimes of the challenges facing Europe as "innovation society", particularly in the face of the challenge of energy transition in the face of climate change. This action should encourage students to take ownership of European policies while being a force for proposal.

The budget foreseen for these actions is 45,000€, and the duration of the project is 8 months (September 2021 - April 2022). With the "European Researchers Night" which will be organized once again in Nice this year, "I AM Europe" is part of the actions of public awareness and interaction with the ultimate beneficiaries of the results of the projects, which are more and more important for research players.

Marie S.-Curie Actions: looking forward to the publication of the finalized Work programme and the first call for projects

A preliminary version of the 2021 - 2022 work program of pillar 1 - "Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions" was published by the European Commission. Download the document.
