Throwback on the Nice Europe Day

On the occasion of Europe Day, celebrated in May each year, Nice marked the moment with **Nice Europe Day**, which took place on May 14 at the Jardins Albert 1er, as part of the Europe week cycle of events. The event ultimately welcomed more than 6,000 people at the music stand on that day alone. It was organized by the Centre Europe Direct Nice and Université Côte d'Azur was also present to speak with the general public about our projects concerning youth and the territory.







EUA Conference "Spotlight on Recognition" (Brussels, 13/05/2022)

The «Spotlight on recognition» project (july 2020-june 2022) carried out by the European University Association (EUA) with the German and Spanish Rectors' Conferences – HRK and CRUE – and the Deutsch NUFFIC organization as partners, was the focus of a final European conference in Brussels on may 13th 2022. When higher education institutions (HEIs) are the final decision-makers for academic recognition in most countries of the European higher education area (EHEA), this Erasmus+ co-funded project aims to support HEIs by enhancing their capacities for recognition practice in compliance with the Lisbon Recognition Convention (LRC) on recognition of qualifications concerning higher education in the European region.

Indeed difficulties in recognizing comparable academic degrees remain in Europe, from one institution to another, from one country to another, despite the LRC principle of fair and transparent recognition of higher education qualifications unless substantial differences can be demonstrated, and despite various tools available: in particular, the ENIC-NARIC information centers' network (Enic-Naric); the overall qualifications frameworks at the European level (QF-EHEA [Microsoft Word - AppendixIII.docx (ehea.info)]; and EQF [The European Qualifications Framework (EQF) | Europass]) which national qualifications frameworks must be compatible with; the European standards and guidelines (ESG) for quality assurance [European Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in the EHEA 2015 MC 613727.pdf] and the DEQAR database [Database of External Quality Assurance Results - EQAR]; or even the EAR manual [European Area of Recognition - EAR Manual (enic-naric.net)].

So in order to support HEIs in improving their recognition practices in compliance with the LRC, the «Spotlight on recognition» project which included various webinars and training actions for recognition practitioners led to set up a database with resources available on the web through the <u>Academic Recognition Hub</u> and to develop a self-assessment tool [<u>Publications (eua.eu)</u>] (available in english, french, german and spanish). And in order to get a common understanding about recognition, this "Spotlight on Recognition" project also proposes to link a <u>recognition community-of-practice</u> open to the staff responsible for academic recognition at HEIs.

Academic recognition and ULYSSEUS [Ulysseus - Ulysseus European University]:

A workshop of the EUA conference made it possible to present what the ULYSSEUS European University alliance's project actually means for education, with development goals concerning joint degrees besides double and multiple degrees, and a widened offer (MOOCs, summer/winter schools, short programmes, BA/MA/D programmes ...) as well, implying the full expansion of student mobility between the currently 6 ULYSSEUS partneruniversities in Europe.
